

Serger Bag Supply List

Date of Class: 2 Session Class

- Wednesday, March 20 from 10:30 am – 5 pm (Serger)
- Wednesday, March 27 from 10:30 am – 5 pm (Sewing)

Please be setup and ready to begin class at the specified time.

Supplies

- Anna Tote Pattern by Sallie Tomato
- Session 1 ONLY:
 - 8 Thread Serger
 - Power Cord
 - Foot Control
 - Single Fold Bias Binder 40mm
 - Double Fold Bias Binder 28mm
 - Quilt Guide for serger
 - Cording Foot for serger
 - 2-4 Spool Pin Disks
- Session 2 ONLY:
 - Sewing machine with power cord and foot control
 - Basic utility foot
 - Zipper foot
 - Walking foot
 - Bobbin for your machine

Fabric Yardage & Cutting Instructions:

*Because we are adapting the Anna pattern to use a serger and attachments/feet, some of the cutting instructions are different than what is listed in the pattern. Cut according to this supply list only unless where indicated to refer to the pattern. Please cut fabric pieces, make bias strips as indicated below, join shoulder strap pieces as indicated below, and embroider pocket if desired, prior to class.

- Main Fabric (Top panel & Straps binding): 7/8 yard
 - Cut main fabric into **Top Panel** as indicated in Anna pattern instructions. Please also make 5 1/3 yards (192 inches) of 1 inch bias for straps bindings. Note: if you make continuous bias, you can use a 16" by 16" square to give you enough length.
- Contrast A (Lining, Pocket, Recessed Zipper, & Zipper tab): 2/3 yard
 - Cut contrast A fabric into **Lining, Recessed Zipper, Zipper Tab**, and **Pocket** as indicated on pattern instructions. Only cut 2 pocket pieces, not 4. If you want to embroider your pocket, please do so prior to the class.

- Contrast B (Straps, Pocket binding, and Cording fabric): 5/8 yard
 - Cut contrast B fabric into (8) 1 1/8" by 24" strips. Then, sew 2 strips together 4 times to make (4) 1 1/8" by 48" strap pieces following pattern steps 1-3 under **PREPARE STRAPS** on page 1 of Anna pattern instructions. Also cut contrast B fabric into (1) 12" by 1.5" bias strip for pocket binding, and (1) 2" by 46" bias strip for cording fabric.
- Tote Bottom: 1/8 yard each of 4 coordinating prints
 - Cut (2) 2.5" by 18" strips of each print to total 8 strips.
- SF101 fusible interfacing: 1 1/3 yard
 - Cut as indicated on pattern instructions for **Top Panel:** (2) 18" by 10.5", **Recessed Zipper:** (4) 11" by 1.5", and **Pocket:** (2) 7" by 5.5", and (2) 18" by 8" for bottom panel. Also cut (2) 18" by 18" for Lining.
- Heat & Bond Lite: 1/6 yard
 - Cut (4) 1" by WOF
- Soft & Stable: 5/8 yard
 - Cut (2) 19" by 19"
- 5mm Cotton Cord: 1 1/3 yard
- 16" Single Slide Zipper size #5 (Recommended: Sallie Tomato faux metal zippers by the yard)
- Sewing thread for construction (Session 2)
- 4 spools (same color) overlock thread to contrast your main fabric panel for plaid design (narrow lines)
- 2 spools (different colors) of 12 wt thread, Wonderfil Spaghetti or Madeira Decora, for plaid design (wide lines) and wave stitch
- Optional: 2 spools overlock or sewing thread to match main fabric color for straps binding
- Optional: scrap bias fabric pieces to practice using bias binder attachments

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Seam ripper
- Scissor Snips or small scissors
- Size 90/14 universal sewing machine needle
- Quilting pins
- Quilters Select, Mettler or Aurifil thread to match fabric
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler

Class Policy Reminders

- Please have class supplies purchased prior to class.
- No photocopied or sharing of patterns or books will be allowed in classes due to copyright concerns.
- Cancellation Policy: We consider your enrollment to be a commitment by you to take the class and we in turn make a commitment to the instructor. No cancellations are allowed on classes. Thank you for not asking us to make exceptions.
- The Baby Lock Brilliant is available to rent for this class if you prefer not to bring your own machine. A limited number of machines are available on a first come first serve basis. Please contact us to reserve a machine prior to class. The rental fee is \$25 per session* and includes use of the machine and 14 snap on feet. In order to not take away from class time for yourself or other students, you must arrive 30 minutes before class starts to sign a rental contract and inventory the machine accessories. A staff member will also provide an overview on use of the machine at that time. At the end of class, a staff member will again complete an inventory with you. You are responsible for any missing accessories or damage to the machine. In order to ensure the machines stay in good working order, thread must be purchased from Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop.

*If you decide to purchase the machine at the end of class, your rental fee can be applied to the purchase
