

Twass BOM: Let's Applique

Supply List

Date of Class: Saturday, August 31 from Noon – 5 pm

Please be setup and ready to begin class at the specified time.

Supplies:

- Month 1 BOM (pattern, fabric, and fabric placement guide)
- Fusible Web of your choice - Jennifer recommends Wonder Fuse or Soft Fuse
- Moda Soft Fusible Interfacing or SF101, recommended
- Thread of your choice – Jennifer used thread that matched each of the fabrics
- White Permanent Topping, recommended

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing machine with
 - power cord and foot control
 - Open Toe Foot, recommended or Basic utility foot
 - Bobbin for your machine (You can use a neutral thread in the bobbin for all the applique, but I would recommend bringing some empty bobbins as well in case you see some on the top and wind to wind bobbins to match each of your thread colors.)
- Seam ripper
- Weeder or pin for scoring fusible web paper backing
- Glue Stick
- Scissors for cutting the applique – Jennifer recommends the micro serrated scissors by Karen Kay Buckley – they cut a nice smooth edge on your fabric
- Scissor Snips or small scissors
- Size 80/12 universal sewing machine needle
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler
