

Learn to Paper Piecing: Colorburst Quilt Block Supply List

Date of Class: Friday, October 4 from 1-5 pm

Book/Pattern: Colorburst by Sassafras Lane Designs

Fabric Requirements:

- Purchase a kit (The kit includes all fabric, the pattern, and pattern pieces printed on foundation paper for \$39.95)
- **or**
- Select your own fabrics
 - Refer to the pattern for the assorted scraps you will need for the color wheel design
 - I found a fat quarter was not enough fabric for the background and I would recommend 1/3 yard
 - 5" x 5" accent fabric
 - 4 copies of the pattern printed on Paper for Foundation Piecing

Additional Supplies:

- Add a Quarter Plus, highly recommended
The 6" is long enough for this project, but if you think you'll do more paper piecing I would recommend the 12".
- Glue Stick
- Seam Align Glue, recommended for sewing sections together

Prior to Class

- Please cut and label your background fabric according to the pattern instructions.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing machine with
 - power cord and foot control
 - Basic utility foot
 - Bobbin for your machine (wound with the thread you will be using for your project)
- Seam ripper
- Scissor Snips or small scissors
- Size 80/12 universal sewing machine needle
- Quilting pins
- Quilters Select, Mettler or Aurifil thread (I recommend fine Quilters Select thread for paper piecing)
- Cutting mat and rotary cutter

Class Policy Reminders

- Please have class supplies purchased prior to class.
- No photocopied or sharing of patterns or books will be allowed in classes due to copyright concerns.
- Cancellation Policy: We consider your enrollment to be a commitment by you to take the class and we in turn make a commitment to the instructor. No cancellations are allowed on classes. Thank you for not asking us to make exceptions.
- The Baby Lock Brilliant is available to rent for this class if you prefer not to bring your own machine. A limited number of machines are available on a first come first serve basis. Please contact us to reserve a machine prior to class. The rental fee is \$25 per session* and includes use of the machine and 14 snap on feet. In order to not take away from class time for yourself or other students, you must arrive 30 minutes before class starts to sign a rental contract and inventory the machine accessories. A staff member will also provide an overview on use of the machine at that time. At the end of class, a staff member will again complete an inventory with you. You are responsible for any missing accessories or damage to the machine. In order to ensure the machines stay in good working order, thread must be purchased from Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop.

*If you decide to purchase the machine at the end of class, your rental fee can be applied to the purchase
