

Workshop Diva Supply List

Date of Class: Monday, April 14 1:00-5:00 pm

Please be setup and ready to begin class at the specified time.

Book/Pattern: Workshop Diva by Amy Bradley Designs

Supplies:

- Purchase a kit with all fabric and precut pieces included
 - or refer to the pattern for fabric and fusible web requirements
- Thread of your choice. On the sample, Jennifer used 50 weight Aurifil, Tutti, and Mettler that matched each of the fabrics. This makes the thread just blend in to the edge rather than being a focal point. You could also use Invisible thread if you wanted to use one spool for the whole project and not see it. Or you could use a one (or a couple colors) of a finer thread to make it less visible. It's up to you based on what look you'd like.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing machine with
 - power cord and foot control
 - applique foot of your choice. Jennifer recommends the open toe foot or the applique foot
 - Bobbin for your machine (wound with a neutral 80 weight thread. Jennifer uses a med gray. She would also recommend bringing a bobbin wound with black thread).
- Seam ripper
- Scissor Snips or small scissors
- Appli-Fuse Mat
- Fabric marking pen
- Weeding tool, recommended
- Size 80/12 microtex sewing machine needle
- Lightbox, highly recommended

Class Policy Reminders

- Please have class supplies purchased prior to class.
- No photocopied or sharing of patterns or books will be allowed in classes due to copyright concerns.

- The Baby Lock Brilliant is available to rent for this class if you prefer not to bring your own machine. A limited number of machines are available on a first come first serve basis. Please contact us to reserve a machine prior to class. The rental fee is \$25 per session* and includes use of the machine and 14 snap on feet. In order to not take away from class time for yourself or other students, you must arrive 30 minutes before class starts to sign a

rental contract and inventory the machine accessories. A staff member will also provide an overview on use of the machine at that time. At the end of class, a staff member will again complete an inventory with you. You are responsible for any missing accessories or damage to the machine. In order to ensure the machines stay in good working order, thread must be purchased from Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop.
