

Gaia Crossbody Bag Supply List

Date of Class: Tuesday, February 20 from 11:00 am – 5:00 pm

Please be setup and ready to begin class at the specified time.

Book/Pattern: Gaia Crossbody Bag from Little Moo Designs

Fabric Requirements:

- Please refer to the pattern envelope for fabric requirements. If you'd like to make your bag just like the sample, the following was used.
 - ¼ yard Cork
 - 3/8 yard Suede
 - 1/6 yard Pocket Lining & Trim Fabric
 - ½ yard Lining Fabric
 - ¼ yard of Soft and Stable
 - The webbing and Fusible Fleece notated on the pattern were not used for the sample.

Additional Supplies:

- 16" Zipper
- 7" Zipper
- (2) 1" D-rings or O-rings
- (2) Swivel Hooks – The pattern calls for 2", but 1" were used on the sample
- 1 Strap Connector – The same width as your swivel hooks.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing machine with
 - power cord and foot control
 - Basic utility foot
 - Bobbin for your machine
- Seam ripper
- Scissor Snips or small scissors
- Size 80/12 universal sewing machine needle
- Quilting pins and clips
- Quilters Select, Mettler or Aurifil thread to match fabric
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler

Class Policy Reminders

- Please have class supplies purchased prior to class.
- No photocopied or sharing of patterns or books will be allowed in classes due to copyright concerns.
- Cancellation Policy: We consider your enrollment to be a commitment by you to take the class and we in turn make a commitment to the instructor. No cancellations are allowed on classes. Thank you for not asking us to make exceptions.
- The Baby Lock Brilliant is available to rent for this class if you prefer not to bring your own machine. A limited number of machines are available on a first come first serve basis. Please contact us to reserve a machine prior to class. The rental fee is \$25 per session* and includes use of the machine and 14 snap on feet. In order to not take away from class time for yourself or other students, you must arrive 30 minutes before class starts to sign a rental contract and inventory the machine accessories. A staff member will also provide an overview on use of the machine at that time. At the end of class, a staff member will again complete an inventory with you. You are responsible for any missing accessories or damage to the machine. In order to ensure the machines stay in good working order, thread must be purchased from Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop.

*If you decide to purchase the machine at the end of class, your rental fee can be applied to the purchase
